Its characteristics at the time of registration were

Flowers mauve to heliotrope (H2 / H12) in spikes to 8cm long, February–April; corolla urn-shaped, to 7mm long, maximum width 5mm; calyx dark mauve, to 4mm long; anthers very dark red, fully emergent.

Leaves dark green above, pale green below, to 9mm long, linear.

Habit upright, to 45cm tall × 35cm across after 5 years (not pruned).

Differs from ‘Kramers Rote’, more upright habit and more “red”.

Origins: deliberately raised seedling, cross made by Johannes van Leuven in February 2008; selected February 2010; EU-Sortenschutz SR-2 (Torero).
