Its characteristics at the time of registration were

Flowers erect at anthesis, urn-shaped, 8–10mm diameter, H12 (heliotrope), more attractive than ‘Pink Blum’; calyx dark red/green; July–October/November.

Foliage green.

Habit: broad, erect; after 5 years (pruned) 30cm high, 30cm across.

Origins: chance seedling found by J. G. Flecken in 2001 in his garden.
