Its characteristics at the time of registration were

Flowers “double”, all upwards-pointing on pedicels longer than corolla:  
corolla cylindrical, 11mm long, 5mm wide, deep H9 at the base, shading to H2/H12 at tip;  
inner petals white; flowers do not drop after fading; July–October.  
Buds deep H9, develop to good size long before opening, adding very much to the floral display.  
Foliage: deep green.

Habit: nearly upright, spikes a little arching: after 3 years, 25cm tall, 30cm across.  
Origins: deliberately raised seedling; parents include ‘Charles Nelson’ and ‘White Blum’.  
The name Muxoll is the family name of the raiser’s mother.
